Initiation is \$50. Full Iron Horse members pay annual dues to the unit of \$42, Dual membership is \$30.

Do I Need to Own a Motorcycle to Join?

While many of our members enjoy owning their own motorcycles it is not required that you have one to join the unit. However, you must possess a valid motorcycle endorsement on your license.
